I am requesting funding for the Butler Logistics Park Wastewater Treatment Expansion Project as a community project in Fiscal Year 2027.



This funding will support additional capacity for wastewater collection for the growing community near the Butler Logistics Park. Specifically, this funding would be used to develop an equalization and pumping system and install additional lift stations and force mains. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it supports the economic vitality of the county that has seen steady increases in business development and land usage.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
