I am requesting funding for the Revitalizing Industrial Property to Transform Community Health Care Project as a community project in Fiscal Year 2027.



This funding would be used to transform an unused industrial property into a modern facility to provide comprehensive community health services. Specifically, this funding will support the interior build out of the facility, including plumbing and HVAC, electrical equipment, and fire suppression. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will strengthen essential community health infrastructure to address critical community needs, reducing emergency department utilization and expanding preventative care access.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
